KOC Takes Part in 7th International HSSE & Loss Prevention Conference









KOC recently took part in the 7th International HSSE & Loss Prevention Professional Development Conference and Exhibition which was organized by the American Society of Safety Engineers (Kuwait Chapter) under the patronage of Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Oil Mustafa Al-Shamali. The event was held under the theme of "Solutions to Safety Challenges."

The KPC CEO delivered a speech on behalf of the minister in which he asserted the relevance of the conference's theme, while acknowledging the efforts being made by the oil sector in the HSSE domain, particularly by KOC. He enumerated the various awards and certifications garnered by the sector in appreciation of those laudable efforts.

For his part, KOC CEO Hashem Hashem emphasized the importance of such conferences in the enforcement of safety regulations, saying that HSSE is a responsibility that lies with all. He went on to state that the Company diligently endeavors to enhance HSSE systems, adding that those efforts have led to gas flaring to be reduced to 1.3%.

Meanwhile, ASSE President Kathy Seabrook commended the efforts of its Kuwait Chapter, as she expressed appreciation for its initiatives and the pioneering role it plays in the global safety network.



It's worth mentioning that ASSE was founded in 1911 as a voluntary non-profit society which provides professional development, advocacy and standards development in safety.




KOC Signs Contract with Fluor

Kuwait International Petroleum Research Center

An ambitious undertaking for Kuwait



KOC officials recently said that the Company is making great progress in supporting one of the nation's most ambitious objectives which focuses on building a state of the art Petroleum Research and Development Center. The KOC R&D Group has been leading the effort to design and implement the center in collaboration with a highly qualified team of professionals from various KPC subsidiaries. Headed by R&D Group Manager Bader Al-Khayat, the team has made significant progress on the conceptual design of the center and the development of an integrated R&D/TM roadmap.

On the roadmap front, the team defined an integrated overview of prioritized technical challenges faced by the upstream and downstream oil and gas sector in Kuwait. Current efforts are focused on finalizing the identified challenges within five years. On the conceptual design front, the team finalized the pre-feasibility study of the R&D/TM center and secured 250,000 m2 of land. Overall, the center is set to be an architectural landmark in Kuwait that brings in aspects of modern, high-tech architecture with flexibility in design and an emphasis on sustainability.

Defining and setting up the optimal operating model to carry this project forward to execution are the next steps that need to be carried out. This includes designing the optimal organization structure and associated processes, and in addition to scouting for the best resources and partners in order to deliver on the research requirements.

KOC Implements Performance Management & Business Intelligence Project

Initiative to contribute to Company Strategy



Under the patronage of the Deputy CEO (Planning & Commercial) Jamal Jaffer, KOC recently commenced the implementation of a comprehensive system for Performance Management and the Business Intelligence Project with the purpose of keeping track of strategic and operational plans to enhance the Company's performance.

The project is being supervised by the CIT Group and is led by Manager Ali Al-Naqeeb, who maintained that he was keen to ensure the efficiency of the project and provide the optimal technical solutions in this domain.

Meanwhile, the initiative is being implemented by a large group of employees

from different disciplines led by TPL Specialist I Safa Al-Nashmi with the support of Planning & Finance Groups, among others, and in cooperation with EBLA, Infosys and Kuwait Computer Services (KCS).

The project will be implemented for two years followed by four years of technical support operations. The team has organized a series of workshops with various departments within the Company to outline a detailed action plan for the implementation of the project and identify roles in subsequent phases. The first phase of the project was successfully completed through a workshop held on November 28, 2013.

KOC Launches "Clean-up Arabia" Campaign

Al-Basry: Health, safety of community is top priority

For the eighth consecutive year, KOC has launched the annual "Clean Arabia" Campaign which is expected to run until February 25th. The campaign kicked off from the Green Island and also involves the Kuwait Motorcycle Riders Team.
