KPC and Subsidiaries Plant Sidr Trees in Ahmadi Oasis As part of achieving the oil sector's strategic objectives in sustainability



Coinciding with Kuwait's national celebrations, KPC and its subsidiaries organized the second edition of their initiative to plant Sidr trees at Ahmadi Oasis, which is managed by KOC.

The event was attended by His Excellency the Governor of Ahmadi, Sheikh Humoud Jaber Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah, KPC CEO, Sheikh Nawaf Saud Al-Nasser Al-Sabah, and KOC CEO, Ahmad Jaber Al-Eidan, along with other CEOs, representatives, and several leaderships and employees from all K-Companies.

During his speech at the event, Sheikh Nawaf Al-Sabah highlighted the ongoing efforts to achieve the Corporation's strategic sustainability goals, which include tree planting initiatives and the expansion of green spaces. He emphasized the critical environmental role of the Sidr tree, noting its ability to stabilize soil, purify the air, and withstand harsh climate conditions.

For his part, Al-Eidan underscored that the initiative reflects KOC's dedication to balancing its operational activities with its environmental responsi-

bilities. He explained that the planting of Sidr trees in Ahmadi Oasis is an integral part of the Company's broader strategic plans to promote sustainability.

KOC Concludes “Nabd” Educational Initiative

Held in collaboration with the MoE, bringing together 24 schools across Kuwait

KOC held the closing ceremony for the “Nabd” initiative, aimed at raising awareness and educating students about the oil and gas sector. This initiative was organized for schools across Kuwait over several months.

The closing ceremony was held at the Four Seasons Hotel in Kuwait City, with the attendance of CEO Ahmad Jaber Al-Eidan, along with several senior officials from both the Ministry and the Company, as well as representatives from the contributing and partner organizations involved in implementing this initiative.

The ceremony featured the announcement of the winning projects from both boys’ and girls’ schools. Five boys’ schools and four girls’ schools

made it to the final stage, where they showcased and competed with the projects they presented on the last day.

The event also featured a speech by the DCEO for Planning & Innovation at KOC, Mohammed Al-Abduljaleel, who highlighted the initiative’s role in fostering future leadership and strengthening oil industry knowledge among students, thus contributing to the continued development of Kuwait and its diverse sectors.

Following this, the winning projects were awarded. In the boys’ category, the team from Jassim Al-Kharafi School in the Assima Educational District won first place, while in the girls’ category, the winning project came from the team at Omarah bint

- The International Police Federation Show Jumping Championship was held, organized by the Federation under the patronage of the First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Interior, Sheikh Fahad Youssef Saud Al-Sabah, at its racetrack in Subhan. This championship, sponsored by KOC and held over three days, was part of the Ahmadi Sports Day activities organized by the Company. It featured participation from riders from Kuwait as well as other Arab and European countries, and was overseen by a team of international judges. In the presence of Undersecretary of the Ministry of Interior, Major General Abdulwahab Ahmed Al-Wuhaib, and the President of the Kuwait Olympic Committee, Sheikh Fahad Nasser Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah, awards were distributed to the winners on the final day. Rider Abdullah Al-Awadhi won the championship after recording a time of 43.47 seconds in the Grand Prix event over a height of 145 cm. He was followed by riders Hamad Al-Hajri, Ali Al-Kharafi, British rider Chad Fellows, Fawaz Al-Subaie, Anaz Al-Annaz, Rakan Al-Hasaawi, and Zayn Samir. The competitions were held over heights of 100, 105, 115, 120, 125, 130, 135, 140, and 145 cm. First-place winners included rider Faisal Al-Shatti (35 cm), Indian rider Sujobaby (115 cm), rider Ahmed Al-Shabib (105 cm), rider Hala Al-Mulla (130 cm), rider Mohammed Al-Shammari (120 cm), rider Talal Al-Hazim (110 cm), and rider Ghanima Al-Marzouq (125 cm).
- Under the patronage of Manager Medical Group (Ahmadi Hospital), Dr. Mubarak Al-Ajmi, and with the supervision of Chief Medical Support Services Officer, Dr. Faisal Al-Kandari, the Diagnostic Radiology Department at the Hospital organized an awareness lecture at Al-Hayat Universal Bilingual School and Qortuba Girls' Secondary School.
