KOC and SLB Celebrate Successful Application of Advanced Foamed Acid Treatments

In a world-first achievement, utilizing nitrogen foam technology

KOC and SLB celebrated a world-first success in applying Advanced Foamed Acid Treatments in Jurassic Gas fields in Kuwait.

The ceremony, held at Salwa Al-Sabah Hall in Salmiya, saw significant attendance from the leadership and experts of both companies. From KOC, the attendees included Manager Free Gas Operations Group, Abdullah Al-Mutairi; Manager Gas Fields Development Group, Mohammed Al-Bahar; and several Team Leaders. Representing SLB was Reservoir Performance Manager at SLB Kuwait, Ahmad Al-Dousary.

Al-Bahar spoke at the ceremony, noting that for the first time in Kuwait, nitrogen foam technology (Foam N) has been deployed in one of the deepest

and most geologically complex formations in the world, with the aim of reactivating gas wells and improving their productivity.

Al-Bahar also expressed pride in achieving this new technical milestone in Kuwait's oil sector, within formations considered among the most challenging globally, in order to reactivate gas wells and enhance their production efficiency. This step reflects Kuwait's engineering capabilities and pioneering adoption of innovative solutions to the challenges of complex reservoirs.

During the ceremony, attendees praised this historic and distinguished achievement, which reflects a qualitative advancement in well stimulation and simulation technology.

They also commended the joint efforts that came together to achieve this strategic success.

The ceremony featured a live interactive presentation demonstrating the mechanisms of the new technology, and a speech by TL Gas Fields Development (Production) Jassim Barki, who emphasized the strategic importance of partnership and constructive collaboration in achieving future aspirations. He also highlighted that relying on modern technical solutions has been a key pillar in maximizing reservoir development and optimization.

The event concluded with an honoring segment for the technical and engineering teams who contributed to the success of this project.





Coordination Meeting with the MPW on the Railway Link Project with Saudi Arabia

Representatives from all parties concerned with the 85-kilometer route were present

KOC has launched steps aimed at supporting final implementation efforts for the railway link project with the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, following the Municipal Council's approval to allocate the project's right-of-way.

In this context, the Company held a coordination meeting with the Ministry of Public Works, aimed at accelerating the implementation of the 85-kilometer-long project, overcoming all technical and field-related obstacles surrounding it, and ensuring the imminent start of construction works.

At the beginning of the meeting, Manager Public Relations & Information Group in the Company, Mohammed Al-Basry, extended congratulations

on the Municipal Council's approval of the project route, affirming that the oil sector will harness all its capabilities to provide full support to State ministries and institutions, and work to remove obstacles to ensure the smooth progress of this vital national project.

He noted that the Company's technical Teams have worked diligently over the past three years to clear the designated route and

secure all necessary technical approvals to ensure the safety of the railway line.

The meeting witnessed strong attendance from both technical and consulting sides, including several Team Leaders of technical Teams at KOC and KGOC, along with the Director of the Railway Link Committee between the two countries at the Ministry of Public Works, Engineer Nasser Al-Kazemi, and the project's supervisory team, as well as representatives from the GCC Railways Authority.

The attendees reviewed engineering details and proposed maps of the project route, with the aim of finding immediate and practical solutions to the technical challenges facing the work site.

Participants actively engaged with the live Power BI interface, undergoing practical simulations to master data navigation, variance analysis, and live budget tracking.
