Under the patronage of KPC CEO Hashem Sayed Hashem, the 5<sup>th</sup> Kuwait Corrosion Conference and Exhibition took place recently at the Hilton Resort in Mangaf.

KOC CEO Emad Mahmoud Sultan and a number of CEOs and DCEOs from various K-Companies were in attendance, in addition to other K-Company employees and representatives from governmental bodies and private companies. A host of local and international experts also attended the opening ceremony of the conference, which was organized by the Kuwait section of the National Association of Corrosion Engineers (NACE).

In his opening speech, KPC CEO Hashem Sayed Hashem welcomed the audience and expressed his hope that the conference would achieve its goal of sharing important information and best practices related to pipeline maintenance and

## KOC Marks 28<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Extinguishing of the Last Burning Oil Well

Event held in cooperation with the Kuwait Environment Protection Society



KOC recently marked the 28<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the extinguishment of the last burning oil well through two events featuring a large ceremony and exhibition.

Under the patronage of KOC CEO Emad Mahmoud Sultan, and in cooperation with the Kuwait Environment Protection Society, the Company organized the event at the Four Seasons Hotel. During the event, the CEO delivered a speech in which he highlighted the efforts of the heroes of the Kuwaiti Fire Team and their achievements in extinguishing a large number of burning wells in record time.

Team Leader Soil Remediation Projects (II) Muthanna Al-Momin delivered a presentation in which he listed the accomplishments of the Soil Remediation Group. Two short films were then screened, one of which included an interview with members from the Kuwait National Focal Point.

In addition, a book titled "Restoring the Nature of Kuwait" was launched during the

ceremony. The book is the result of a collaborative partnership between KOC and the Kuwait Institute for Scientific Research. It details the enormous efforts made by the Company to remediate Kuwait's environment after the invasion.

At the closing of the ceremony, a film was screened which focused on the efforts of the late Kuwaiti Minister of Health, Dr. Abdul Rahman Al-Awadhi, in the field of environmental protection.

The second event included the establishment of a booth at the Avenues Mall which commemorated the anniversary in an innovative way. The booth included two large screens through which an interactive game was displayed for children to play. The game mimicked the efforts of the firefighters in extinguishing the oil well fires, clearing mines, and stopping oil spills. The booth also included a window in which the clothes and tools of the firefighters at the time were displayed.



## KOC & KEPS Work Toward Environmental Protection

Int. Day for Preventing Exploitation of the Environment in War & Armed Conflict observed



Under the patronage of the Minister of Oil and Minister of Electricity & Water Dr. Khalid Al-Fadhel, and in partnership with KOC, the Kuwait Environment Protection Society (KEPS) recently commemorated the "International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict."

KOC CEO Emad Mahmoud Sultan, a number of DCEOs, Group Managers, Team Leaders, representatives from the Ministry of Defense, the Ministry of Interior, the National Guard, the Kuwait Environment Protection Society, Directors of the General Directorate of Fire Services, and a host of guests attended the ceremony, which was held at the Four Seasons Hotel in Kuwait City. The ceremony coincided with the 28<sup>th</sup> anniversary of extinguishing the last burning oil well.

KOC CEO Emad Mahmoud Sultan delivered the inaugural speech on behalf of

the Minister. The Chairwoman of the Board of the Kuwait Environment Protection Society, Wijdan Al-Oqab, delivered a similar speech.

A short film titled "Why 6 November?" was then screened. The film commemorated the anniversary of extinguishing the last burning oil well, as well as the International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict, which was sanctioned by the UN at the request of the State of Kuwait. During the ceremony, tokens of appreciation were presented to government entities, sponsors and organizers. KEPS also awarded the "Medal of Environmental Champions" to the heroic firefighters who participated in extinguishing the oil well fires in 1991, with the award also being presented to youngest firefighting volunteer during the invasion.

On the sidelines of the ceremony, a special exhibition was held which focused on the Kuwait Environment Rehabilitation Program.





## KOC Inaugurates 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase of Chemical Injection Project

The oil enhancement project plays an important role in KOC's 2040 Strategy



Under the auspices of KOC CEO Emad Mahmoud Sultan and a number of his Deputies, the second phase of the project to promote oil extraction through the use of chemical injection technology was launched at the Sabriya Maudud reservoir in North Kuwait, making it the first project in the world to use this technology in a carbon reservoir.

The inauguration ceremony was attended by DCEO Exploration & Gas Ahmed Al-Eidan, DCEO North Kuwait Ali Al-Kandari, DCEO South & East Kuwait Bader Al-Munaifi, DCEO Planning & Finance Bader Al-Attar, and a number of Group Managers and Team Leaders.

The second phase of injecting treated water comes in preparation for chemical injection, about two years after the launch of the first phase of the project. This new initiative, which is of great strategic importance to KOC and the State of Kuwait, is the first of its kind in the world, in addition to being an important aspect of the 2040 Strategy which contributes to boosting production and increasing reserves.

The third phase of the project is expected to be launched in early May of 2020. The project consists of five phases.
