KOC hosts the 6th of November celebration

Organized by the Kuwait Environment Protection Society in cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs



KOC hosted the 6th of November Celebration of extinguishing the last oil well, and the International Day for Preventing the Exploitation of the Environment in War and Armed Conflict, which was organized by the Kuwait Environment Protection Society in cooperation with the Kuwaiti Ministry of Foreign Affairs under the slogan "In the wake of the oil disaster, is the rehabilitation of lands affected by oil pollution", at the Ahmed Al-Jaber Oil and Gas Exhibition in Ahmadi.

The ceremony was attended by Deputy Foreign Minister for International Organizations Affairs Counselor Abdulaziz Al-Jarallah, representative of the sponsor of the celebration, His Excellency the Minister of Foreign Affairs Sheikh Salem Abdullah Al-Jaber Al-Sabah, a number of ambassadors and diplomats to the State of Kuwait, representatives of Ministries, official bodies, and institution, UN organizations, and invited guests.

At the beginning of the celebration, Al-Jarallah gave a speech in which he stated that the adoption of the International Day by the United Nations was a Kuwaiti initiative, out of Kuwait's belief in the necessity of engraining the values of protecting the environment.

Khalid Al-Otaibi, delivered a speech in which he thanked everyone who contributed to extinguishing the oil wells, recalling the heroism and sacrifices of the members of the teams that contributed to extinguishing the fires, and stressing the need to learn lessons from what took place.

Al-Zaid also touched on the Company's cooperation with a number of parties in the Environmental Remediation Program, and thanked them for their efforts.

This was followed by two speeches, from the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kuwait Environment Protection Society Dr. Wejdan Al-Uqab, and representative of the United Nations, Mazen Abul-Hassan.

Organized by KOC in cooperation with Shell and highlighted successes and lessons learned



With the attendance of DCEO Gas & Innovation Bader Al-Munaifi, Manager Gas Fields Development Group Moudi Al-Ajmi, and a number of Managers, Team Leaders, and concerned employees, the North Kuwait Jurassic Gas Technology Day was held in partnership with Shell.

The workshop, which was held at the Hilton Resort, had multiple objectives, including maximizing learning and knowledge sharing from the North Kuwait Jurassic Gas asset's technology maturation and implementation successes and lessons, demonstrating and documenting the significant value added through technology and innovation, and presenting the asset's technology plan to improve alignment between KOC's assets and functional teams and identify any synergies and cooperation opportunities.

Workshop with Shell to discuss the Gas Production Capacity Roadmap

It aims to achieve a level of approximately 950 million cubic feet by 2024



In the presence of Manager Gas Fields Development Group Moudi Al-Ajmi, KOC organized a workshop with Shell to discuss a road map for achieving a gas production capacity estimated at 950 million cubic feet by 2024, as well as for the launch of the eighth and ninth annual plans for Jurassic Gas in North Kuwait in cooperation between the two companies.

The event was attended by Team Leaders in the Gas & Innovation Directorate, and managers from Shell, as well as a large number of employees from the Drilling, Drilling Engineering, Well Surveillance, Gas, Production, and Innovation Groups.

In her opening speech, AI-Ajmi emphasized the importance of

achieving the goal of producing 950 million cubic feet of gas, followed by presentations on the achievements that have been made within the framework of the Enhanced Technical Services Agreement for Gas during the past years, as well as visual presentations on future plans, results, and expected achievements for the next two years within the framework of the Agreement.

After that, discussion sessions were held to exchange ideas in an effort to increase gas production, with the aim of achieving the Company's Strategy regarding production, and developing a plan for the next two fiscal years 2023-2024, then 2024-2025.
