In the presence of DCEO Admin & Finance Qusai Al-Amer, and DCEO Gas & Environment Ameena Rajab, the closing ceremony for the first and second batches of the Integrated Training Program for Natural Gas Processing Engineers was held. This is the first specialized program of its kind in the oil sector, organized by KOC in cooperation with Kuwait University.

The ceremony took place at the Sabah Al-Salem University City, College of Engineering & Petroleum in Shadadiya. The Local Relations Team held a coordination meeting with the Environment Public Authority to discuss the use of oil drilling fluid in emergency situations within the offshore exploration drilling project.

The meeting was chaired by TL Local Relations Abdulaziz Hamada, and attended by TL HSE & Drilling Excellence & Workover Abdulaziz Al-Rushoud, TL Drilling-I (S&EK) Dakhil Al-Enezi, along with several officials and specialized engineers from the three Teams.

At the start of the meeting, Hamada welcomed the attendees and thanked them for accepting the invitation. This was followed by a presentation delivered by Senior Drilling Engineer from Drilling Team (31) Ahmed Al-Jalahma, who briefly outlined the offshore drilling project and its importance. He also explained the role of drilling fluid, its uses and benefits, and highlighted areas for coordination and cooperation on this matter.

It was agreed to maintain ongoing coordination on the matter, with KOC to provide the Environment Public Authority with a detailed report on the drilling fluid and its applications. Additional meetings will be held in the future if necessary.
