KOC Hosts GCC Meeting on Oil & Gas Infrastructure Protection

Attended by high officials from the GCC, friendly nations, and Kuwaiti government agencies



KOC hosted a high-level meeting on Oil & Gas Infrastructure Protection and Crisis Management, organized by the General Secretariat of the GCC Emergency Management Center (EMC), in cooperation with the United Nations Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT).

The three-day program was conducted at the Ahmad Al-Jaber Oil & Gas Exhibition. The opening session was attended by several high-ranking officials, including Assistant Secretary-General for Security Affairs of the GCC Brigadier General Hamad Al-Ameemi, Chairman of the GCC EMC Brigadier General Dr. Rashid Al-Marri, KOC Deputy CEO for Commercial & Corporate Services Musa'ed Al-Rasheed, Representative of the UN Secretary-General & Resident Coordinator in the State of Kuwait Dr. Ghada El-Taher, and H.E. the Russian Ambassador to the State of Kuwait Vladimir Zheltov.

The meeting's coordination was led by Head of the UNOCT Madrid Programme Office and Coordinator of the UNOCT Global Programme on Protection of Vulnerable

Targets, Ignacio Ibáñez. The event was attended by representatives of GCC countries, as well as friendly nations, close allies, and various Kuwaiti government agencies.

The event began with virtual addresses by H.E. the GCC Secretary-General Jassem Albudaiwi, and Under-Secretary-General of the UNOCT Vladimir Voronkov. In turn, DCEO Musa'ed Al-Rasheed expressed KOC's pride in hosting this event at such a critical time, highlighting the challenges facing the oil and gas industry. He stated that the region is a vital source of global energy and that Gulf energy assets play a central role in maintaining global energy market stability.

The event featured speeches by a number of attending officials, as well as panel discussions that addressed several related issues and sought practical solutions.

Representing Kuwait, KOC's HSE Group Manager Nasser Al-Buhairi joined senior officials from Gulf states in a panel discussion on energy security and the current and future threats facing the oil and gas industry in the region and worldwide.

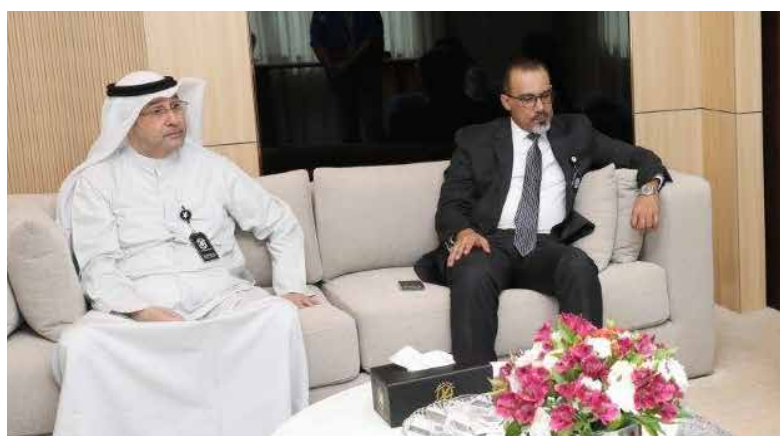

Under the patronage and with the attendance of His Excellency the Governor of Ahmadi, Sheikh Humoud Al-Jaber Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah, KOC hosted the “Less becomes more when you save” event, organized by Ahmadi Governorate in cooperation with the Company, and the Ministry of Electricity, Water and Renewable Energy (MEWR).

The event was held at the KOC Tent in Ahmadi, and also attended by the Undersecretary of the MEWR, Dr. Adel Al-Zamel, Deputy CEO Planning & Innovation at KOC Mohammad Al-Abduljaleel, and Ag. Manager PR&I Group Bedor Al-Sayed Omar. A large number of KOC officials, K-company employees, and government representatives were also in attendance.

Dr. Al-Zamel’s speech followed, in which he thanked the Governor

for his generous patronage and ongoing support, and KOC for hosting the event, confirming that this is part of the ongoing cooperation between the three sides. He highlighted that this event comes at a critical time in terms of climate change and a rising demand on electricity and water, and that turning to renewable energy is essential for future generations. He also expressed his sincere appreciation for the Kuwaiti youth working at the Ministry for their roles in securing Kuwait’s energy needs.

The event also featured several informative awareness videos on electricity and water conservation.

For her part, Head of the Information & Awareness Team for Conservation at the MEWR Khadija Abdulredha Mishari delivered a presentation titled “Saving to Achieve Sustainability” where she reviewed scientific and practical solutions to energy consumption, which included sustainable buildings, energy efficiency, lighting alternatives, efficient electric devices, water waste, and cost savings.

Following the presentation was the discussion session under the title “The Future of Renewable Energy and How it Will Affect the Quality of Life”, in which TL Drilling & Workover Technical Services (VI) at KOC Ghazi Al-Besairi, and Engineer Sulaiman Al-Khaldi from the MEWR participated, presenting the Sidrah 500 Project and the Shagaya Project, respectively.
