Kuwait hosts WPC Energy Youth Forum and Annual Meeting

A week-long program of activities and meetings with distinguished local and international participation



Over the course of a week, Kuwait hosted the activities of the 8th World Petroleum Council Energy Youth Forum and Annual Meeting. Among them was the central event, the official opening ceremony, held under the patronage and in the presence of His Excellency the Minister of Oil Tariq Suleiman Ahmad Al-Roumi, at the Jumeirah Hotel in Messila.

The event was distinguished with high-level local, regional, and international attendance. This event was hosted by the Kuwaiti Ministry of Oil, while all activities were organized by KOC in cooperation with KGOC.

Notable attendees at the opening ceremony included H.E. the Secretary General of the Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) Haitham Al-Ghais, H.E. the Secretary General of the Organization of Arab Petroleum Exporting Countries (OAPEC) Jamal Al-Loughani, the Undersecretary of the Ministry of Oil H.E. Sheikh Dr. Nimr Al-Sabah, the CEO of KPC Sheikh Nawaf Saud Nasser Al-Sabah, the CEO of KOC Ahmad Jaber Al-Eidan, as well as several executives from the Kuwaiti oil sector. Additionally, the President of the WPC, Pedro Miras, and H.E. the Secretary General of the International Energy Fo-

rum, Jassim Al-Shirawi, were also present.

The opening session included speeches by H.E. Minister Al-Roumi, the OPEC Secretary General, the Undersecretary of the Ministry of Oil, the WPC President, and the IEF Secretary General. The session also featured an introductory video about the occasion, which was followed by an awarding segment honoring key officials and students from various universities, as well as participants from the Sabah Al-Ahmad Center for Giftedness and Creativity.

Afterward, the discussion sessions on the forum's theme commenced. The forum, the largest global event for youth participation in the energy sector, was held this year under the theme "Empowering the Future: Connecting Young Professionals, Ideas & Knowledge". Its program was based on three main pillars: Nurturing the Changemakers of Tomorrow; Youth-Driven Innovation, Sustainability & Growth; and Including Youth in Strategic Decision-Making of the oil sector.

The week included numerous activities and meetings for council members, including visits to several facilities and tours of popular and cultural sites in Kuwait.





Follow-up Meeting on the Latest Developments in the Ahmadi Souq Project

Chaired by the Governor of Ahmadi, and attended by international experts



The three parties involved in the Ahmadi Souq Development Project held a high-level meeting to follow up on the latest developments in this project and review local and international technical opinions and procedures.

The meeting was chaired by His Excellency the Governor of Ahmadi, Sheikh Humoud Jaber Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah, in the presence of KOC CEO Ahmad Jaber Al-Eidan, DCEO Commercial & Projects Engineering Musaed Al-Rasheed, and the Acting Assistant Secretary-General for the Antiquities & Museums Sector at the National Council for Culture, Arts, and Letters, Mohammad bin Redha.

Also attending from the Company were Manager Public Relations & Information Group Mohammad Al-Basry, TL Information Bedor Sayed

Omar, as well as several specialists and experts involved in the project from the NCCAL.

During the meeting, opinions from technical and cultural entities were reviewed, with contributions from representatives of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), who provided detailed explanations of the technical requirements related to the implementation of this pioneering development project.

At the end of the meeting, the next practical steps were agreed upon, including the coordination and follow-up mechanisms between the various local and international parties and the individuals responsible for overseeing them.

KOC participated in the SPE Annual Technical Conference & Exhibition (SPE ATCE), held over four days at the George R. Brown Convention Center in Houston, Texas, USA.

KOC and Shell hold ETSA Exploration and NVG Framing Workshops

Held over two days, bringing together top leaders and technical experts from both companies



In a strong demonstration of partnership and technical collaboration, KOC, in cooperation with Shell ETSA, successfully hosted a two-day workshop focused on ETSA Exploration and New Venture Group framing.

The event took place at the Jumeirah Hotel in Messilah and brought together top leaders and technical experts from both companies.

The workshop was attended by KOC's Manager Exploration Group Jarrah Al-Jenaie, Manager New Ventures Group Talal Al-Adwani, along with both Groups' Team Leaders and KOC technical experts. Representing Shell, ETSA Manager in Kuwait Anwar Al-Mutlaq participated alongside Shell ETSA specialists.

On the first day of the event, participants engaged in a comprehensive review of current exploration efforts, including KOC project goals, Triassic and Paleozoic prospect maturation, drilled hole analysis, regional mapping, geochemistry, drilling strategies, and proposed

workflows. The sessions featured insightful presentations from both KOC and Shell specialists, fostering open dialogue and a valuable exchange of expertise.

The second day of the workshop focused on NVG scope, to fast-track new fields development in Mutriba HUB, and support the urban planning of the area.

Speeches were delivered by Al-Jenaie, Al-Adwani, and Al-Mutlaq, where they emphasized the critical importance of collaboration, integration, and a unified approach to exploration and new venture activities. All three speakers reinforced their commitment to leveraging the ETSA to unlock value across KOC assets, and praised the strong, trust-based relationship that continues to grow between KOC and Shell.

The workshop highlighted the technical advancements being made through the shared KOC-Shell journey, and underscored the shared vision of both companies to drive innovation and achieve long-term success through joint efforts.


The purpose of the visit was to enhance training cooperation and exchange expertise. During the ceremony, introductions were made between the visiting trainers and the officials responsible for organizing
